

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
July 8, 2010 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 8, 2010 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and four visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-stop sign enforcement and brush cutting on River Road, cold patch material, grader use; Jack MacDonald-VanGorder Mill Road culverts, Lovers College at Portersville Road weeds.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the June 10, 2010 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented.

It was announced that Boots and Zias and Marshall attended the County Commissioners meeting held at the WPVFD hall and that Boots has been following up by attending the regular Commissioners meetings concerning the repair of West Lancaster Road bridge located in Franklin Township.

The new engine for the WPVFD was on display prior to the meeting for residents and the Supervisors to see.

Zias motioned and Boots second to advertise the 1999 Chevy 1-ton truck "As is" for sale. Motion passed with all in favor. The condition of the building roof was discussed with Boots to take care of patching, replacement of the gutter and painting of the VFD roof section.

Boots motioned and Zias second to advertise for bids for repairs to McCartney Hollow Road Bridge. Motion passed but was later rescinded with Boots motion and Zias second and all in favor of the rescind. Telephone bids were received for the work with the following motions passed:

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Beachem's Sandblasting Service sandblast the McCartney Hollow Bridge and take care of the tarps and removal of material for the price of \$4293.50. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Beachem's Sandblasting Service sandblast the Barkley/Levis Road Bridge and take care of the tarps and removal of material for the price of \$4997.50. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Beachem's Sandblasting Service sandblast the Barkley Road Bridge by Pine Lake Road and take care of the tarps and removal of material for the price of \$3892.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Boots purchase and be reimbursed for the material/sealer for the bridges if the township is unable to increase the credit limit to \$5000. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to raise the Visa credit card limit to \$5000 per the recommendation of Greg Fox, Solicitor. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that the office would be closed July 9 to the 18th. Following presentation of the past years winter material use, it was decided not to submit a bid request to the COG for road materials.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 7-8-10 Opposition to Legislation to Eliminate Townships. Motion passed with all in favor.

The new truck is expected in August from Walsh Equipment. The "Spot Check" audit of Liquid Fuels is complete and everything found to be in order. Boots to assist with the report to the District office concerning storm scour reports of bridges.

Boots motioned and Zias second to advertise the Residential Weed Control Ordinance for adoption at the August meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was decided no action to be taken on the sewage enforcement fee policy, an ordinance on holding tanks and a ordinance for oil and gas recovery.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
