

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
October 14, 2010 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 14, 2010 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and six visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-water problem on roads and lack of funds, McCartney Hollow Road catch basin, doing well with fund and Vine Way brush; Barbara Zias-visiting from California; Patty McCullough-Mike Mazure cars and Jenkins trash; Ray Bauder-Magee winter maintenance.

It was announced that there was an executive session held prior to the meeting concerning personnel issues. An executive session was held following the meeting concerning litigation.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the September 9, 2010 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The tax collection, Roadmaster and permit reports were presented

Zias motioned and Boots second to set and advertise the budget workshop dates at October 18 and 25 at 5:00 p.m. at the municipal building. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to ratify the approval of "Ranch Lane" for a private lane off of Mile Hill Road. Motion passed with all in favor. This is following the recommendation of the 911 Center.

It was announced that the tax collection location and hours are changed to Tuesdays only from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. at Dorothy Wallace's residence at 3790 State Rt. 488 effective October 18. Those coming to the township office will still be able to pay their taxes there.

The letters from Penndot of the 2011 anticipated Liquid Fuels Allotments have been received with the amounts to be \$78,787.20 and \$15,360.

It was also announce that the flood zone letters were sent out to residents owning property in flood zones.

The township must adopt the County Storm Water Ordinance by March 13, 2011. This was tabled until the 2011 Reorganization Meeting.

Zias motioned and Boots second to advertise for an external auditing firm to be appointed for the 2011 audit. Motion passed with all in favor.

The 2011 rate for UC will increase with a new surcharge of \$792.92 for the 2007-2009 benefits paid.

The decision will need to be made about collection of delinquent earn income taxes for the 2011 year and whether to have Berkheimer collect them or not under a separate contract.

Trick or Treat is October 28 and the Fire Department haunted house runs from October 27-30.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
