

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
December 13, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 13, 2012 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary-Treasurer Janice Marshall and Solicitor Greg Fox were in attendance. There were four visitors present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Comments were received from Delores and Denise Zadalak about a parking problem on Rifer Street. The Supervisors are to check into it.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the November 8, 2012 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Tax Collection Report, the Roadmaster report and township permit reports were presented.

Schlemmer motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 12-13-12-1 the 2013 Year Budget Funds Appropriations. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 12-13-12-2 the 2013 Year Tax Levy for Perry Township which set the taxes at: General Purpose Tax at 1.79 mills which reflects a 1/2 mill increase; Water Tax at .29 mill; Fire Apparatus Tax at .50 mill; Light Tax at \$.48 for developed and \$.12 for undeveloped road frontage, on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to advertise the Perry Township 4:00 p.m. January 7, 2013 Supervisors reorganization meeting and the Perry Township Auditors January 8, 2013 reorganization meeting, time to be determined before the advertisement. Both meetings are to be held in the Municipal Building. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to ratify the renewal of the Insurance Policies with the Kilmer Insurance Group with took effect December 1, 2012 through December 1, 2013. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to ratify the sale of the Massey Ferguson tractor, which was sold for scrap for \$555.54. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to ratify the trade-in sale of the shop air compressor for \$125 and the purchase of a used Hamilton/Campbell air compressor for \$675. Motion passed with all in favor.

Following discussion of the sale of the 1987 International truck it was determined to keep it until April and to advertise it at that time. It was decided not to send any funds to the Lawrence County Tourist Agency. Information on the tax bill printing by Infocon is tabled until information is received from Dottie Wallace as to who the school is to use.

It was noted that more township properties and trailers have been entered into the County Repository Account. Communication from Berkheimer about Centax was discussed.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to ratify the purchase of commercial grade gutter for the front of the township building through Paul Boots Contracting for \$1247. Motion passed with all in favor.

The road crew was thanked for the snow fence put up on Pfeifer Road. Possible disability insurance on the road crew was tabled until the Reorganization meeting.

The building roof is complete and looks good. The letter was received from the PennDot auditor, which found the Liquid fuels funds to be in order.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to adjourn. Motion passed.
