

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
June 14, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 14, 2012 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor Greg Fox was in attendance and acting Secretary/Treasurer. Supervisor Tim Boots and Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall were absent. There were two visitors present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- River Road berm mowing and repairs to F550.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the May 10, 2012 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented.

Notice was received of a COG sponsored Municipal Oil and Gas symposium on July 31 and reservations will need to be made by the week of July 25th.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the telephone low bid from Suit-Kote at \$625 per hour for equipment rental and manpower in place for double seal coating Magee and part of Pfeifer Roads.. Motion passed with all in favor. Russell Standard was the only other bid at \$725 per hour. AR Oliastro, Youngblood Paving and Smith Paving were contacted but submitted no bid.

The County Planning Office was contacted about amending the Land Development Ordinance to increase a minimum lot size for on lot septic and water with no assistance in a sample amendment being available.

Schlemmer received a thank you for the brush cutting at State Route 488 and Pine Lake Road.

Building repairs are tabled until fall.

Status of the work on Wilson Avenue and 401 Portersville Road was discussed.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to set August 18 as the date for the township community yard sale at the municipal building. Motion passed with all in favor. The Supervisors expressed approval at the May meeting with the following stipulations: Someone to be present from the township so that the bathrooms will be open, nothing is to be furnished, must bring own table, must register upon arrival, anything not sold must be taken with them, and the area must be cleaned up at end.

The Supervisors submitted a letter grant a waiver for a right-of-way width change from 18 foot to 20 foot for an existing driveway on the Bill Marshall property pending approval from the Lawrence County Planning Office.

It was announced that the State and US flags have been received from Rep. Gibbons.

A motion to adjourn was received with all in favor.
