

Perry Township Board of Supervisors March 8, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 8, 2012 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 6 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski, Nye Road condition, Levis Road condition and salt usage,

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 9, 2012 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. It was announced that the Charles Loll Company completed the 2011 financial audit with no comments on any problems.

The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented. Residents were reminded of the County Outreach Program for payment of county taxes that will be held at the township building on April 19 from 9-12:00.

Boots motioned and Zias second to award the bids for summer bid products to the lowest bidder through the Lawrence County Regional COG. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias is to get hold of Aiken Roll Off's to set the Spring Clean-up Day for the first Saturday in May if possible. The three Supervisors are to coordinate a spring road inspection day.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second for Marshall to get an item to donate for the PSATS Convention in May. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Lawrence County Association of Township Officials will be holding their Spring Convention on May 16, 2012 at the Wurtemberg-Perry Twp. Firehall. All township officials and their spouses are invited with the cost to be \$16.00.

Marshall is to send a letter to Armstrong to have the company submit a contract proposal for the 2014 renewal. The Supervisors and Greg Fox were given a copy of the current contract.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Greg Fox send a letter to Brian and Brenda Behm about their refusal to obtain a building permit for a shed they erected last fall, which wasn't permitted. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that F. B. Taylor Engineering was approved by the PennDot Consultant Agreement Section for the appointment of the engineer consultant for Perry Township.

The action for the Emergency Operations Plan was tabled until next meeting until the CD is received from the Public Safety office.

Zias motioned to adjourn and Boots second with all in favor.
