

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
April 11, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 11, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 11 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-road sweeping, location of grader, status of paver; Dave Weller-thank you for repair to hole on Breakneck Bridge Road; Gene Donley-Stickle Road condition and lack of work on it causing vehicle damage, concerns about fire department access and ACTS bus; Jeff VanDiver-Stickle Road and damages to vehicles; Susan Greene-condition of Hickernell Road; Lon Duncan-landfill changes, he is to begin recycling certain electronic devices and request to collect them at the township clean-up day on May 18. The Supervisors granted Duncan's request. Tim Boots responded to the road complaints commenting he plans to work on Stickle, Bauder Mill and Barkley Roads.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the March 14, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and permit reports were presented. Boots motioned and Zias second to pay for the township officials who want to attend the Lawrence County Township Assoc. Convention May 15. Motion passed with all in favor. SEO Doug Duncan contacted the township office about the need for review of the township septic agreements and holding tank ordinance.

Marshall submitted a request to be reimbursed for the \$1,145.97 withheld from her pay as tax collector in 2010 that paid for the tax collector laptop and program. An executive session was held following the meeting to discuss it further.

Residents were reminded of the Spring Clean-up Day for May 18, 8-12:00 and to charge a fee of \$ 5.00 for each load received.

Greg Fox presented a draft of a Fire Escrow Ordinance for the Supervisors to review for the next meeting.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to appoint Sue Duncan as Auditor to finish the 2013 following the resignation of Keith Beachem. Motion passed with all in favor.

Residents were reminded of the County Tax Outreach Program for Perry Township is Thursday April 18, 9-12:00 in the municipal building.

The purchase of the building doors was tabled. The bids were opened by the Lawrence Co. COG and the Supervisors should be receiving the contracts soon. Boots took care of getting the extended warranty for the 2011 F550 truck.

There were three bids received for the repairs to the 2005 JCB: Reedy \$7800; Walsh \$8304.80; Hufnagel \$6629.55. Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to award the repair of the 2005 JCB backhoe to Jason Hufnagel at the cost of \$6629.55. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to advertise for the Sale of the 1987 International dump truck including the snowplow. Motion passed with all in favor.

May 4th at 8:00 a.m. was set for the Supervisor road inspection. Cohen Law Group is currently working on the Armstrong Cable Agreement for the 2014 renewal.

Greg Fox is to draft an Ordinance to address the enforcement of township ordinances by the township police chief/officer. F. B. Taylor Engineering was notified to proceed with the weight limit study. Sue Duncan will assist Marshall with the Community Yard Sale.

Boots motioned and Zias second to get bids for a marquee sign. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned to adjourn and Schlemmer second with all in favor.
