

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 13, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 13, 2014 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor, Coty Brandon was present and sat in for Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall who was absent. Three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski: WPVFD fish dinners, where F550 is; Roy Magee: Barkley Road/State Route 488 Intersection.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the February 13, 2014 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the submission of the 2014 Summer Bid items to the Lawrence County Regional COG for bidding. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to pass Resolution3-13-14 Authorization for the Chairman, John Zias to sign all paperwork pertaining to the Barkley Road Bridge #2 Project. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second for Zias to proceed with signing all documents for the Barkley Road Bridge #2 Project and the engineering agreement. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to permit the placement of a clothing bin on the township property that will benefit the Special Olympics. Motion passed with all in favor. Following the motion action, it was decided for Zias to get further information on the bin.

Boots is to get a bid for the purchase of a new Viking trailer and find out the value of the Belmont trailer the township owns. Boots is to also get bids for a V-Box for the Peterbilt for possible purchase before fall. The type of winter ashes used by the township was discussed.

The possible rental of a sweeper for the Wurtemberg area was discussed along with the schedule time frame for sweeping.

The township clean-up day was set for May 3 from 8-12:00 with a \$5.00 fee per load. The sale of the scrap brought in on the clean-up day was discussed: Boots wants funds to go to road crew, Zias feels township should get the funds to offset the cost of the day. Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to pay the Supervisors labor pay for assisting with the clean-up day. Motion passed with all in favor.

Possible sale of the Lee-boy Paver was discussed with the decision to keep it. Boots discussed petitioning the Lawrence County Reg. COG about purchasing a chipper.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase a new desk for the office not to exceed \$500.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

Discussion of the John Deere 300B tractor leak and possible sale.

The Subdivision Land Development/Cell Tower Ordinance was discussed. Boots discussed the Stormwater Ordinance compliance for the construction of a building on the Dave Aiken property and stated that DEP is taking care of it and the township is not involved in the matter.

Those in attendance were reminded of the County Outreach day April 10 from 9-12:00 at the township building. Boots checked into changing cell phones and the cell phone plans. Waiting on more information. The coverage on employees for eye and dental was discussed with no action taken.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
