

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
April 10, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 10, 2014 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall was present. Four visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Mr. and Mrs. Richard Schilling-Levis Road construction and land acquisition/widening on their property – a discussion by Roadmaster Tim Boots followed with explanation of wider than 23' in some areas, no more infringement to be done on their property, right-of way markers to be put in place; Sam Pawlowski: River Road ditch, Memorial Day activities, blood drive.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the March 13, 2014 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

The Supervisors are to set a date and time for the spring road inspection. The estimated figures were presented for work on Reno Road.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to release the Fire Apparatus requested funds to the WPVFD for the purchase of new Self Contained Breathing Apparatus once an invoice and amount is submitted to the township. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second for the Secretary to participate in the Ethic Webinar at the cost of \$30.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

Those township officials who will be attending the Lawrence County Convention on May 14 need to get their reservations into the secretary before May 5.

The grant applications for the Reno Road work and the Barkley Road Bridge #2 have been submitted to the Lawrence County Commissioners.

A complaint was received about a pot hole on Palo Alto and vehicles not stopping at the intersection of Portersville Road and Mercer Road.

Boots and the solicitor are to work with the Secretary on the letters for the water line on Grandview Road.

Boots submitted the price for a new Viking trailer at \$13,000 and the value of the township Belmont trailer is between \$800-\$1,200.

The township clean-up day date was changed to May 10 from 8-12:00 due to a conflict with the fire department. The fee for a load will still be \$5.00.

It was decided to go ahead and submit the paperwork for the clothing bin to be placed at the township property.

Jan Marshall thanked the Supervisor for the floor painting and new desk.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
