

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 11, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 11, 2014 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, and four visitors were present.

Supervisor Paul Schlemmer called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Delores Zadalak-neighbor's dog messing in their yard; Helen Boots-Wehman Lane sign and who is responsible and where to get a replacement sign, a sink hole along Portersville Road east of Dewitt's Junkyard.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the August 14, 2014 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

Boots discussed the summer road work which will involve VanGorder Mill Road, West Lancaster Road, Levis Road and Reno Road. The work will possibly be done the week of the 16th.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to grant permission for Daniel and Brandy Moffatt to have multiple dwellings located on their property involving the existing dwellings. Motion passed with all in favor.

A list of bridge work that was published in the local newspaper showed the year and funds to be used to work on Perry Township bridges.

A letter was received from Rex Energy that they have secured the gas lease from Shell Appalachia for the township property.

Boots motioned to hire Dana Butia as township solicitor, the motion died for lack of a second. Schlemmer requested it be tabled until the October meeting when all three Supervisors are present.

The status of the Grandview Road water line was discussed with the review of the surveys received so far. It was also noted that Mark Leonhardt passed away and that the access for the water line to be run across his property will probably not be done as no written permission was ever received and the estate will need to be settled.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to advertise in the Ellwood City Ledger for the intent to appoint a certified public accountant for the 2014 financial audit at the November meeting. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase gift cards to reimbursement each of the road crew for damage done to their clothing while putting tar on the roads. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to adjourn. Motion passed.
