

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
August 13, 2015 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 13, 2015 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and 1 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road, Butler Avenue, location of grader, Nye Road and McCartney Hollow Bridge; Zias commented on the need for the weeds to be cut at River Road and Mecklem Lane and that River Road needs cracked sealed.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the July 9, 2015 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Tax Collection, Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Boots discussed the work to be completed on Lookout Avenue by the road crew instead of having the work bid out once the repairs to the McCartney Hollow Road Bridge is finished: repair bad spots, put R4 Rip Rap in ditches, put curb in place, work on culvert and spot tar and chip. Zias asked about a culvert and catchbasin by the VFD drive to which it was agree is needed.

Schlemmer questioned the condition of Hickernell Road after the tar and chipping done. Boots commented that he is satisfied with the ditch and catch basin above Amadios at the end of Hickernell Rd. Zias asked for the ditch to be cleaned out that extends the Hickernell Rd. ditch down to the creek.

A letter is to be sent to the District 11-0 office that Perry Township will not enter into an agreement to maintain the sidewalk that is in the designs for the new second bridge.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Roy Jenkins get a tanker endorsement at the township expense and that Czerpak and Houk are approved as well. The distributor trailer is to be pulled only by the International and Peterbilt trucks. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer is to get the names of companies to do the entire River Road for sun lighting River Road within the right-of-way, straight up only. To have for the September meeting.

It was noted that Franklin Township is using the paving machine temporarily while theirs is being repaired. It was decided there is no interest in putting an advertisement in the historical society paper.

The next round of the Dirt and Gravel Road program for the spring of 2016 is due November 23. The conservation office is to be contacted for possible roads to be included: Shingle Hollow, Pfeifer, McCartney Hollow, and Studebaker.

The Supervisors agreed to have Davevic take over the brokerage for Guardian and that they are to be check with to see the limitation of the dental plans, etc.

The Rex Energy well and tank pads need for a land development was discussed. It was decided to let the county planning and Rex work out the request.

Zias motioned and Boots second to advertise the John Deere 300B for sale. Motion passed with all in favor.

The approximate cost for the tar and chipping projects this summer was \$109,956.01 not including labor and fuel and equipment costs.

The license for the distributor trailer is still being processed. The traffic barrels have been ordered.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to adjourn. Motion passed.
