

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 12, 2016 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 12, 2016 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-Barkley Road work, West Lancaster Road Bridge; Kathy Parks-VanGorder Mill Road lights, trash along VanGorder Mill Road. It was questioned as to who owns Creekside of VanGorder Mill Road.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the April 14, 2016 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 5-12-16, Regulations for Campaign Signs on Township Properties. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the low bids for all the emulsion products and cold patch. Suite-Kote had the low bids for delivery of cold patch- \$83.75, E-1 Emulsion-\$ 1.10; CRS.2-\$1.13. Youngblood had the low bid for FOB of CRS-2 - \$1.165. The FOB award will depend on the distance and availability of pick-up of the product. If Youngblood is unable to full fill the order, Russell Standard will be the second bid due to Suit-Kote being located in Meadville and too far for FOB. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase an exhaust fan for the shop for up to \$500.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

More information is needed on the purchase of flexible delineator's for marking culverts, etc. Following a request for culvert/ditch work for 556 Morningstar Drive in Franklin Township, it was determined that Franklin Township maintains the street, but Boots is to check on it with their road crew.

Summer road work was discussed with Boots to contact Suit-Kote about their procedure for leveling roadways. Possible roads to be considered are Studebaker Road and Bauder Mill Road. The distance for the procedure is to be a minimum of two miles. Roads slated for summer work are: Lookout Avenue, Raymond Street, Barkley Road sections by Cayes and by Stickle Road, both ends of Nye Road, and both ends of Pine Lake Road.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a Sweepster Brand Tow Behind Road Sweeper from Walsh Equipment through the CoStar Program for no more than \$17,500. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 5-12-16-2 to submit a request to the Lawrence County Commissioners for a grant from the County Liquid Fuels Funds in the amount of \$15,000 to go toward the purchase of the two sweepers for the road department. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that there are regulations from DEP concerning burning. It was also announced that Brian Schweinsberg will receive a low income house repair through the program between Ellwood City, Ellport and Perry Township.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
