

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 9, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 9, 2017 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawloski-Grandview Road condition, skid steer and paver location; Kathy Parks-the mirror at VanGorder Mill and Route 488 intersection needs adjustment, time frame for second bridge replacement, police coverage cost.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 9, 2017 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 3-9-17, Authorization for Supervisor Tim Boots and Secretary Janice Marshall to be the authorized signers and contacts for the pension fund documents. The Pension fund is for the full time road laborer employees following a motion passed at the January 3, 2017 meeting to establish the same. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots is working on getting the cost and company information.

Boots motioned and Zias second to set the Perry Township Clean-up Day for June 3, 2017 at the township and fire department parking lots. Motion passed. There will be a \$5.00 fee per load and the regulations will be the same as last years.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the purchase of a Hydro Tek hot steam pressure washer from PED Company for the shop at the cost of \$3,759.99. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Radich second to purchase two Stihl MS 251C chain saws with cases, one 16" bar and one 18" bar at the best price. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to give the two non-functioning chain saws to James Radich and Roy Jenkins. Motion passed with all in favor.

Residents are reminded of the Lawrence County Tax Outreach and VA identification day will be at Perry Township on March 30 from 9-12:00. Veterans can receive their ID cards if they bring their service discharge documents.

The township will need to order two more loads of salt to complete the required amount from COSTARS.

Boots motioned and Radich second to ratify the advertisement for the special meeting for the bid letting date of March 16, 2017. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to send a letter requesting a study be completed by PennDot on the intersection of Portersville Road and Lookout Avenue. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pay the JCB Backhoe loan off. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that a bin for clothing and shoes is to be put on the township parking lot through a group for paralyzed vets.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
