

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 10, 2011 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 10, 2011 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 12 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-West Lancaster Bridge status; Patty McCullough-junk on River Road, ditches on Mecklem Lane and Wilson Avenue, code enforcement officer; Tim McLaughlin-Magee Road condition and if scheduled for repairs; Mr. and Mrs. Ray Roccon-West Lancaster Bridge, Shingle Hollow Road condition, emergency vehicles and Marcellus drilling; Ray Roccon-Shingle Hollow Road condition; Jeff Cable-road miles, ditching of roads.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 10, 2011 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented.

Wurtemberg-Perry Twp. VFD Fire Chief Mark McDevitt presented concerns about the closing of Portersville Road this spring and the accessibility for fire equipment response. Included in his concerns were water sources, time factors, Mile Hill Road and Stickle Road conditions. The Supervisors expressed willingness to help with concerns.

Telephone bids are to be gotten for the spring clean-up day in May - 1. Two twenty yard boxes and two garbage trucks; 2. Four twenty yard boxes. Need to check for possible tonnage charges also.

Mark McClymonds was thanked for his assistance this winter. Boots motioned and Zias second to pay for an advertisement for McClymonds Supply and Transit in the 2011 Lawrence County Township Association Booklet and for two dinners to the annual dinner for Mark McClymonds and a guest. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to adopt the Lawrence County/Perry Township Stormwater Maintenance Ordinance, to set the penalty fee at \$1,000.00 and to add in the Review Fee Reimbursement Agreement in section Article VI: Fees and Expenses. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to amend the Lawrence County/Perry Township Stormwater Maintenance Ordinance to be effective on March 13, 2011. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to ratify the bid request for summer products to the Lawrence County Regional COG which include: 750 tons of 1B limestone, 400 tons of #57 limestone, 400 tons of R-3 rip rap, 100 tons of premium cold patch, 15000 gallons of E-3 Emulsion, 6000 gallons of on road low sulfur diesel, 700 gallons of heating oil, 2- 55 gallon drums of 14-40 all fleet motor oil, 2 - 55 gallon drums of tractor fluid, 3 cases of anti-freeze, 10 of 30"x30" stop signs, 25 of 20' x 15" n-12 Smooth Interior plastic culvert pipe; 12 of 2'x4'x3' catch basin; 12 of 2'x4' high frame for catch basin; 12 bicycle grates. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to amend the sample flood plain ordinance from DCED to be Perry Townships Flood Plain Ordinance and make the Supervisor's changes and submit it for the final state review before our final action toward adoption. Motion passed with all in favor.

Residents were reminded of the County Outreach Program for payment of county taxes that will be held at the township building on March 31 from 9-12:00.
