

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
July 11, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 11, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor, Greg Fox, Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 4 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-brush cutting, bridge #2, paver status, road conditions and road work for summer, gas line, F550 problems; Coty Brandon-interested in solicitor position; Susan Greene-Kriebel property in disrepair at 717 Portersville Road and thank you to Supervisors for recognition of "Hero's" for saving woman's life from a house fire; Denise Zadalak-ditch on Meadowland Ave.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the June 13, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and permit reports were presented.

Shell Appalachia purchased and delivered signs for farm equipment use of Breakneck Bridge Road. It was noted that the bridges on North Tower Road and Heinz Camp Road are scheduled to have the weight restrictions lowered.

The proposed procedure for Highway Occupancy Permits (Road Opening) is to be reviewed for the specifications by the Roadmaster.

It was decided not to submit winter material quantities to the COG for bidding. Boots is to check with Ruth Yvorra about placement of a sign on her property and to table the purchase of a marquee sign until the determination.

Boots is to contact the Conservation Director about the Dirt and Gravel Road program.

The Property Maintenance and Fire Escrow Ordinances were tabled. Boots is to check into the condition of the fans in the shop. It was noted that the fire chief inspected all four junkyards per the request by the Supervisors.

Seal coating is to be done on Bauder Mill Road-1/2 mile; Hickernell Road-1/4 mile; and Stickle Road- approximately 1/4 mile.

Following complaints, Boots is to check on Meadowland and Robin Street properties. It was announced that three steel doors have been ordered for the municipal building.

The Community Yard Sale is set for July 20 from 8-2:00 p.m. at the municipal building with the 27 as a rain date.

Delvy McElwain, Norma Boots and Tim Boots submitted a petition on July 9, 2013 for additions to the Agricultural Security Area in Perry Township.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to appoint new members to the Agricultural Security Area Committee: Jodi Rock replacing Keith Beachem and Delvy McElwain replacing Tim Boots. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to advertise the petition for the Ag. Security Area. Motion passed with all in favor.

An executive session was held following the meeting on personnel issues and the resignation of Greg Fox as solicitor.

Zias motioned to adjourn and Boots second with all in favor.
