

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 12, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 12, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor, Coty Brandon, Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 4 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- brush cutting, tractor repairs, Stickle Road seal coating.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the August 8, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to advertise the Armstrong Cable Ordinance/hearing for the October 10th meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Agricultural Security Area Committee submitted a letter in favor of the amendment for the addition of Timothy Boots, Delvy McElwain and Norma Boots farms to the Area. No correspondence was received from the Lawrence County Planning Department so their position is deemed as favorable per the law.

The repairs to the jointly owned Speed Trailer have been turned over to the Lawrence County Regional COG. Reimbursement was received for the circuit board the township paid for.

The signs on Nye Road were discussed with the decision to place "No Winter Maintenance Signs" just past the Caldwell and McElwain driveways.

The Worker's Compensation Insurance Coverage was discussed with the township employees to remain the same with EMC Insurance but the Fire Department to apply to the State Workers Insurance Fund for coverage.

The Solicitor is to send a letter to Charles Kriebel and Susan Greene about the condition of their lawn/yards.

Boots and Marshall are to meet next week to work on the MS4 paperwork/requirements.

It was agreed to get a cleaning person to clean the meeting room, bathrooms and office areas once a month prior to the monthly meeting for \$50.00.

The status of several items included: the renewal of the UPMC health insurance, the Anthony Agostinelli building permits, the Highway Occupancy Permit information needed from Tim Boots, the ProGas tank purchase for \$368.15 per the August motion.

Boots motioned and Zias second to request a \$500.00 payment for damages from JB Mill Logging Company for damages to Stickle Road. The payment is to be received before the bond is to be released. Motion passed with all in favor.

The status of the McCartney Hollow Road Bridge and the repairs to Levis Road and Reno Road were discussed.

Zias motioned to adjourn and Schlemmer second with all in favor.
