

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
April 8, 2010 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 8, 2010 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and nine visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Roy Magee-condition of Barkley Road and need for catch basin; Patty McCullough-River Road stop signs, house at corner of River and Portersville Road, burning ordinance, street sweeping; Ray Bauder-condition of Magee Road and when to be done; Sam Pawlowski-use of asphalt zipper.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the March 11, 2010 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented.

The Supervisors discussed the Internet and TV connections for the meeting room through Armstrong Utilities.

It was noted that the magazine, Roads and Bridges was renewed at no cost for the township.

Linda Webb contacted the township in appreciation for the good work done this winter. Zias stated that several residents in Wurtemberg also commented about the good work done.

The Pleasant Hill Cemetery Association sent a thank you for the use of the meeting room for their meetings.

Zias reminded residents that the township clean-up day would be May 8 from 8-12 and stated what items will not be accepted.

Residents were reminded of the importance of returning the Census papers and the need for seeing identification if someone comes to their door representing the Census.

Boots gave an update on the one truck and equipment ordered through Allegheny Ford and Walsh Equipment. Secretary Jan Marshall stated she is working with ESB Bank to complete the loan paperwork.

Marshall contacted the County Commissioners and was told that no decisions have been made concerning 2010 liquid fuels allocations.

The Supervisors discussed information received from a company in Ellwood City about a Web page for the township.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
