

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 13, 2010 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 13, 2010 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and nine visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Bob Phillips from Thought Process Enterprises presented information about a website for the township; Jack MacDonald-VanGorder Mill Road edge breaking up and concrete culverts separating; Patty McCullough-thank you for stop signs, speeding and police patrol, demolition activity at Laszlo property and on street.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the April 8, 2010 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented.

It was announced that the new engine has been delivered on April 28 at the Wurtemberg Perry Township Fire Department. Zias stated that the truck would be brought out to the next meeting for residents to see.

Items discussed and tabled were: an ordinance for sewage holding tanks; policy for sewage enforcement fees; an ordinance for Oil and Gas Recovery; and an ordinance for residential lot weed control.

Zias motioned and Boots second to pass Resolution 5-13-10 Support of the Wurtemberg Perry Township VFD purchase and loan for a new engine. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to purchase 21 work shirts and 13 sweatshirts with reflective stripes for the road crew and roadmaster. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias responded to complaints about speeding in the school zone. The State Police have been contacted and further information is to be forwarded to them. The Supervisors and residents discussed with many concerns, the County Storm water Plan that the Township is required to adopt. Discussion also was held on the Bill to have the county take over the municipalities.

The Supervisors agreed not to contact the county for the small recycling containers. It was announced that the regular audit is complete and the liquid fuels audit will take place in June. Everyone was reminded to vote at the election on Tuesday.

Zias presented a report on the township clean-up day with everything going well. Boots stated that delivery of the truck is expected to be in June and that the loan has had verbal approval with the paperwork to be completed for the June delivery.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have Thought Process Enterprises set up the website for Perry Township and work with the secretary under the \$500 plan. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
