

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
February 11, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. James Radich was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, three visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-PA One Calls by Perry School; Garrett Banyay – was attending as a Boy Scout to work toward a merit badge, he discussed scout projects.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the January 4, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. A report was received from the township auditors – Supervisor compensation was set at \$16.00/hour for Roadmaster and working Supervisor was set at \$15.50/hour and the reimbursement for mileage is set at the federal rate of \$.56 per mile.

The 2020 Financial audit for the Perry Township Funds was completed by Herrman and Loll and the Perry Township Tax Collection financial audit was also completed. No findings were found for either audit.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

The road repair project for Lesnett Road was discussed and the possibility of applying for county assistance. Zias motioned and Boots second to pass Resolution 2-11-21 Lawrence County Transportation Funding Grant Application. Motion passed.

The Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day will be held at the Perry Township Municipal Building on March 24 from 10:00-12:00 for the payment of 2021 Lawrence County Taxes.

The SEO is to continue following the compliance of the Frank property on N. Camp Run Road and the Geohring property on Pleasant Hill Road and Rust property on W. Lancaster Rd.

The County Township Association meeting is on February 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at Wayne Township. The Associations Spring Convention is May 19<sup>th</sup> at the WPVFD fire hall.

The Armstrong Cable Contract was discussed and it was decided to not use Cohen Assoc. to review the contract.

The Costar Salt contract has been submitted for the 2021-22 year – 60 tons.

A complaint was received about the stop signs at Route 488 and Mercer Roads and drivers not stopping. It was decided to put the reflective stripping on the posts to try to make more visible.

The International truck bed is being repaired for a cost of approximately \$3,000.00

Boots motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
