

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
February 14, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 14, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, John Zias. And James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-McCartney Hollow Road slide area status.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the January 7, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. A report was received from the township auditors – Supervisor compensation was set at \$16.00/hour for Roadmaster and working Supervisor was set at \$15.50/hour.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

The contract has been submitted to Infocon for the 2019 taxes billing.

Announcements: WPVFD Gun Show is February 23 & 24 and their Clay shoot March 30.

The Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day will be held at the Perry Township Municipal Building on March 21 from 9:00-11:00 a.m. for the payment of 2019 county taxes.

A recycling bin has been delivered from Valley Waste to try for three months. It was also announced that the county will hold special recycling collections on the second Tuesday monthly with the locations to be announced.

The County Association meeting is at Wayne Township at 6:00 p.m.

Boots motioned and Zias second to donate \$100 to the Ellwood City Area Easter Egg Hunt Committee for two golden eggs. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was decided to request to have the McCartney Hollow Bridge to be repaired next on the TIP Grant Program with the Barkley Road Bridge by Cayes to be second.

Davevic notified the township that it is in compliance with the health insurance requirements.

Boots motioned and Zias second to have the Township Clean-up Day on May 11<sup>th</sup> from 8-12. Motion passed with all in favor.

Solicitor Greg Fox is to contact the Municipal Authority about their insurance coverage.

Discussion about having the paving company do a 1 ½ overlay from the end of the Barkley Road paving job to Nine Hill. To have Bill Humphrey from F.B. Taylor Engineer get a cost estimate from the contractor.

Boots to contact a resident on Rutter Street about an extremely bright light.

Communications were received from Penn Power, the BAS Boundary Census, and the CODE.Red alert system.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a waterfall tailgate chipper for the 2018 F550 through Stephenson/Costars for up to \$5,000. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to repair the International truck at Keystone Spring for approximately \$12,000. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
