

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
March 8, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 8, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radich, Tim Boots and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Roy Magee-leaves in ditch on Barkley Road.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 8, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. It was reported that the 2017 Financial Audit has been completed with no findings per the audit representatives. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Those in attendance were reminded that the Mountville Road Bridge is set to close from March 6 through November 2, 2018. The Route 488 second bridge over the Slippery Rock Creek is set to close from April 2 through the end of July. And that the Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day will be held at the Perry Township Municipal Building on March 22 from 9:00-11:00 a.m. for the payment of 2018 county taxes.

The Miller property complaint status was discussed with the Supervisors deciding to have the township Solicitor file charges in the Lawrence County Court House. The secretary is to get information to him for filing.

The status of the John Tindall Estate was discussed now and it was determined that the junk yard renewal permit is not to be sent to Herman Stafford, the operator of the "Herm's Mountville Salvage", but it will be sent to the executor of the Tindall and McCullough Estates.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the signing of the documents to combine Perry Township with Ellwood City and Ellport Borough for the low income housing grants. Motion passed with all in favor.

A letter has been received that there will be no grant funding through Lawrence County this year.

The Perry Township Clean-up Day is set for May 12 from 8-12:00 with the fee of \$10.00 per load to be charged.

Marshall is to contact Mahoning Township about the Asphalt Zipper status – Resolution and insurance payment and buy out of Ellwood and Neshannock.

Mr B's changed the lights in the parking lot. Lights were hard to find.

It was reported that Ron Young has left Code.sys but the company will still provide coverage for UCC inspections.

Boots motioned and Zias second to advertise the summer product bids for bid letting at the April meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Marshall is to attend a meeting in Bridgeville concerning the North Tower Road bridge over Funk Run.

Boots motioned and Zias second to refund \$133.33 to Deanna Shaffer for delinquent taxes paid in 2012-2015 for a trailer that wasn't on their property-per the county resolution. Motion passed with all in favor.

No contract was received from PennDot for the winter maintenance of Pleasant Hill Road. Boots to check on the possibility of doing an agility for work on McCartney Hollow Road slide area – placement of gabion baskets at bottom of slide area.

The suggestion was received to have a construction company come in and do the widening of the McCartney Hollow Road by the slide area and remove the tree stumps.

The Peterbilt Truck transmission is still not working right – to take it to Transaxle for repairs. The F550 plow bracket on the truck was discussed.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
