

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 12, 2015 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 12, 2015 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and four visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sgt. Dristol from the New Castle State Police gave a brief report and asked if there were any questions; Sam Pawlowski-commended road workers, commented on potholes; Dave Weller-asked for dirt to be put back in place and his damaged culvert to be repaired from the winter maintenance.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the February 12, 2015 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection, and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to reimburse Janice Marshall for a Hoover Floor Scrubber. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to participate with Ellport Borough and Ellwood City in submitting application for a joint housing grant for low income residents. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass the Policy to permit an absent Supervisor to take part in the decision making procedures during meetings by speaker phone when the absence is due to a medical leave. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to have the township cover the expenses for whoever attends the Municipal Permitting and Integrated Water Resources workshop in Oil City on April 10. Motion passed with all in favor.

Following discussion, the road crew is to move the Bash Lane sign from the end of Hilltop Lane back to the Bash Lane location/driveway where should be.

The Secretary provided the Supervisors with the total expense for winter maintenance from January to March 13: \$52,259.63 – excluding equipment expense.

It was noted that Mrs. Zadalak complained about neighborhood potholes, noise, lack of sleep and equipment parking.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase repairs for the LeeBoy Paver. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots is to take care of doing the traffic count for the submitting roads for the Dirt and Gravel Road Program.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to send a letter to Dorothy Wallace asking for her to get the appointment of a deputy tax collector to the supervisors for approval so they could get it off the agenda. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
