

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
March 14, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 14, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, John Zias and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor was present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road condition and construction company obligations to repair the road, not the township.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 14, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The 2018 Financial Audit is completed with all ok. Questions were raised by the auditor about the possible need for a single audit on the Income spent for the Barkley Bridge replacement. They are to contact F.B. Taylor Engineers.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. Boots discussed road work and the status of the McCartney Hollow Road slide area and road widening project. Need one more load of road salt to meet the contract amount for the 2018-19 year.

Boots motioned and Zias second to delete the meeting tape recordings after six months. Motion passed with all in favor.

The state proposal for compensation to be paid to State Police was discussed. The Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day is March 21 from 9-11:00 a.m.

The cost for Valley Waste will be \$122.00 per month with pick up to be every week.

The Lawrence County Township Convention is May 15 at the WWPVFD fire hall.

Discussion about having the paving company do a 1 ½ overlay from the end of the Barkley Road paving job to Nine Hill. Waiting for Bill Humphrey from F.B. Taylor Engineer to get a cost estimate from the contractor to see if we will need to bid it out.

The Township Clean-up Day on May 11<sup>th</sup> from 8-12 with the fee to be \$10.00 for automobiles. Boots motioned and Radich second to leave it up to the discretion of the Supervisors at the sites to charge up to \$60.00 per load for large trucks, trailers and containers. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Pleasant Hill Cemetery Association will hold their annual meeting on April 1 at 7:00 p.m. at the township building.

Solicitor Greg Fox is to contact the Municipal Authority about their insurance coverage.

The repairs to the International truck at Keystone Spring was discussed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise the summer bid products. Motion passed.

The need to clean up behind the township buildings was discussed. Zias is to check on the location of the Speed Trailer in Ellwood City.

Boots discussed changing the set-up on the Distributor Trailer to use a battery instead of the trucks to heat the emulsion. Boots stated that the road berms would be graded this year.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
