

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
April 2, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 2, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and no visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: No visitors attended.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the March 12, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster report was presented.

Announcements: The Perry Township Clean-Up Day is May 9 from 8-12:00 – has been cancelled. May reschedule in June – depending on virus situation.

Boots and Zias discussed the interim billing for property changes and decided not to pass a resolution for such billing.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the Declaration of a Disaster Emergency for Perry Township, Lawrence County, PA in response to the COVID-19 virus that is worldwide and affecting the United States, causing massive shut-downs, medical concerns and deaths. Said virus includes the Perry Township residents and businesses. Motion passed with all in favor.

Residents are reminded to complete their 2020 Census forms that will benefit all residents and the funding that the township and various organizations could be eligible for.

The Perry Township Office is closed temporarily due to the COVID-19 Virus. The Secretary monitor, when possible, the messages and take care of the mail/bills, etc.
