

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
April 8, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 8, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, one visitor were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road, Vine Way, County Line Street at Nicolson Ave.

Zias motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the March 11, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tim Boots is to check on a culvert pipe on Whieldon Avenue.

Boots motioned and Radich second for Larry Woods to do the summer lawn mowing at the rate of \$40.00 per mowing. Motion passed.

May 1<sup>st</sup> is the Perry Township Annual Clean-up Day. Fees of \$10 and \$50 per load is to be charged.

Another complaint was received about the Martha Miller property/trailer on Hickernell Road. The owner's niece was contacted and is planning on removing the trailer this summer.

The American Rescue Fund Act was passed which will result in Perry Township receiving \$182,609 over two years. Funds have restricted use for COVID-19 expenses.

Action on the purchase of a JCB 110 EW Dig All was put on hold until the next meeting. The Supervisors and road crew are to meet for discussion of the purchase.

The summer products bids were opened. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the low bids for the summer products. Motion passed Results were:

Aggregates: McClymonds Supply & Transit: 800 tons #8-\$21.82/ton; 600 tons #57-\$18.77; 400 tons R-3 Rip Rap-\$19.17; 100 tons R-4 Rip Rap-\$19.17; 100 tons R-5 Rip Rap-\$32.18.

Emulsions: Russell Standard-50 tons Premium Cold Patch-\$84.00; Russell Standard-10,000 gallons FOB CRS-2 Emulsion-\$1.65; Midland Asphalt-30,000 gallons delivered CRS-2 Emulsion-\$1.758

Fuels – no bids were received.

Various complaints were discussed with the Solicitor to send letters.

Zias motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
