

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
April 11, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. John Zias was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road condition; Sgt. Don Sankey-introduced himself, discussed township crime rate low at the present time, just attending to hear any comments or concerns.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the March 14, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. Boots discussed a junk problem on Barkley Road, a letter is to be sent with a copy of the nuisance ordinance.

Boots motioned and Radich second to ratify the passing of Resolution 4-11-19 for the installation of the stop sign at the exit from the Perry Elementary School that intersects with Meadowland Avenue. The sign was placed due to a dangerous situation for children walking to school and vehicles not stopping. Motion passed with all in favor.

The township office will be closed during the state convention in Hershey next week.

Boots motioned and Radich second to ratify the telephone bid award of \$19,450.00 to Sharon Paving for the paving of Barkley Road from Barkley/Nine Hill intersection to the portion done by Sharon Paving for the Barkley Road Bridge Project. Youngblood bid was \$21,750; Russell Standard, Suit-Kote and Smith Paving did not submit a bid. Motion passed.

Items discussed were the repairs to the streets in the Wurtemberg area; a special meeting will be held April 25<sup>th</sup> for the summer product bids to be opened and awarded; the Lawrence Co. Township Association Convention May 15.

The solicitor contacted the Perry Township Municipal Authority about their insurance coverage.

The final inspection of the Barkley Road Bridge is set for April 16<sup>th</sup> with the bridge to be opened mid-April.

A reminder that the Township Clean-up Day is May 11<sup>th</sup> from 8-12 with the fee to be \$10.00 for automobiles. Boots motioned and Radich second to leave it up to the discretion of the Supervisors at the sites to charge up to \$60.00 per load for large trucks, trailers and containers.

The repairs to the International truck at Keystone Spring was discussed with the truck back but still not right.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
