

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
April 12, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and John Zias. James Radich was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Delores Zadalac-curb needs replaced by her house, snow plowing, Palo Alto work; Ray Bauder – Magee Road is bad, culvert replaced has settled.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the March 8, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. The various agenda items carried over were reviewed with discussion of their status.

The Miller property complaint status was discussed with the Supervisors deciding to have the township Solicitor file charges in the Lawrence County Court House. The secretary is to get information to him for filing.

The status of the John Tindall Estate was discussed now and it was determined that the junk yard renewal permit is not to be sent to Herman Stafford, the operator of the "Herm's Mountville Salvage", but it will be sent to the executor of the Tindall and McCullough Estates.

The Perry Township Clean-up Day is set for May 12 from 8-12:00 with the fee of \$10.00 per load to be charged.

Boots motioned and Zias second to award the summer product bids to McClymonds Supply and Transit – aggregates; Russell Standard-CRS-2 and E-1Prime; Suit-Kote-cold patch; and Reed Oil-fuels. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the approval of two non-building waiver permits recommended by the County Planning and SEO. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the signing of a letter/contract for the Barkley Road Bridge right of way and for the PennDot right of way. Motion passed.

It was announced that the office will be closed the week of April 21.

Boots discussed road work to be done this summer: River Road, Bates Road, and Breakneck if funds are available. The McCartney Hollow Road slide area is to be worked on as well.

Boots motioned and Zias second to purchase two fire Xtinguishers for the road crew to carry in their trucks in case of witnessing a structure fire. Motion passed with all in favor.

Marshall is to check with the requirements of a Wesbanco credit card.

The proof of worker's compensation insurance has been received from the Perry Township Municipal Authority.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
