

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 8, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 8, 2014 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Coty Brandon and six visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-weather, Heinz Camp Bridge, road sweeping and Levis Road; George McCool-ditches need taken care of on Reno Road – his property is being flooded when it rains, an electric problem this winter; Miles Heitzenrater-status of a request for a water line on Grandview Road and the condition of Grandview Road needs worked on.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the April 10, 2014 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

The Supervisors are to set a date and time for the spring road inspection. Boots stated that the road work for the summer will be seal coating of Van Gorder Mill Road, the streets by Perry School, West Lancaster Road from the bridge to Shingle Hollow, and Reno Road repairs and finish Levis Road.

The Count approved two grant applications for the Reno Road: \$7,000.00 from the County Liquid Fuels Fund and the Barkley Road Bridge #2 - \$53,500 from the County Act 13 Legacy Fund.

Boots motioned and Zias second to award the summer bids and sign the contracts for the lowest bidders through the Lawrence County Reg. COG. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Supervisors decided not to submit any financial support to the County K-9 fund. The Supervisors discussed the Grandview water line request during the visitor comment period and are to pursue more information from various sources. Miles Heitzenrater offered his help where needed. The possibility of a Perry Township Water Authority was discussed.

The township clean-up day is to May 10 from 8-12:00. The fee for a load will still be \$5.00.

A meeting with DEP is set for Friday morning about a problem off of Mountville Road.

Boots motioned and Zias second to put the McCartney Hollow Bridge and the bridge on Barkley Road by Albert Cayes on the TIP program for replacement.

Following discussion about a request for a “Granny Plat” on the property of Mindy and Jay Tuttle, Boots motioned and Zias second to approve the application and request for a “Granny Plat” septic situation and to have one Supervisor sign the agreement when it is completed. Motion passed with all in favor. Diane Sheets has requested to put a trailer on her daughter’s house due to ill health. She will need to comply with the Septic regulations and building permit regulations and will be the only one permitted to live in the trailer. It will need to be removed and the septic disconnected within 60 days if she is unable to live there.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
