

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 9, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 9 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Dave and Jane Windhorst-the closure of the Barkley Road Bridge #2, the placement of bridge closed signs; Sam Pawlowski-the Barkley Road Bridge, the gutter on the building, the paver status and the JCB repairs; Gene Donley-thank you for the Stickle Road repairs; Delores Zadalac-curb too low by their house, the status of the neighbors building permit.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the April 11, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. There was an executive session held following the April 11 meeting for personnel issues. Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and permit reports were presented. Solicitor Greg Fox gave his opinion that there isn't anything to be concerned about pertaining to the TAG letter received on the bank funds.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to submit a request for \$65,000 from the Act 13 Legacy Fund-Lawrence County Transportation Aid, for the replacement of the closed Barkley Road Bridge #2 which total replacement cost is \$1,300,000.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

A request from the Lawrence County Conservation Department for the Supervisors to send a letter about the financing cuts to their department was tabled. Rep. Gibbon's office is to be contacted to see where the funds would be from if reinstated.

Boots motioned and Zias second to sell the old steel pipe sections to Leland Marshall for \$25.00. Motion passed with all in favor.

Bids were opened and Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to sell the 1987 International truck and plow to Glenn Freed for \$8,552.00. A second bid was received from Leland Marshall for \$8,526.00. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Schlemmer second for Boots to contact Freed to pay for the truck within 10 days with a certified check or the sale would go to Marshall. Motion passed with all in favor.

Residents were reminded of the Spring Clean-up May 18 from 8-12:00 with a \$5.00 fee per load. The Community Yard Sale is to be July 20 or 27. The Fire Escrow Ordinance was tabled.

Schlemmer motioned and Zias second for Marshall to be reimbursed for the \$1,145.97 she paid as tax collector in 2010 for the tax collector laptop and program. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase three fiberglass doors and frames and kick plates for the township building for up to \$600.00 each. Motion passed with all in favor.
