

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 9, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. John Zias was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road, Grader location, McCartney Hollow slide status

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the April 11 and April 25, 2019 meetings. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. It was announced that the Barkley Road Bridge is now open.

Following complaints about a property on Wilson Avenue, Boots talked to them and they are in the process of cleaning it up.

Boots to check into moving a stop sign at Line Avenue and Portersville Road.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a 2019 Peterbilt truck through Hunter Truck Sales/CoStar program for \$85,000. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase items for the new chassis: a stainless steel bed for \$34,194.00, a snow plow for \$12,592.00 and a chip spreader for \$3,792.00 and required hydraulics through US Municipal/CoStars and to be paid for through the lease agreement with Hunter Truck Sales. Any items purchased over the lease amount to be paid for by the township funds. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the lease agreement through Hunter Truck Sales for five years with no down payment. The rate is 4.9% with the monthly payments to be \$2,493.60 for the lease amount of \$133,000. Motion passed.

Decision was tabled for the purchase of an extended warranty for the truck.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 5-9-19 to apply for county aid in the amount of \$20,000 to help with the purchase of the 2019 Peterbilt truck, plow, spreader and bed. Motion passed.

Complaints were received concerning the resident at the corner of Barkley and Pine Lake Roads putting signs up and refusing to let traffic use the Pine Lake Road. Boots to check on and inform them that it is a township road.

Boots motioned and Radich second to have the Barkley Road Bridge #3 be the next bridge for replacement through the TIP Program. Motion passed.

The situation was discussed concerning the Tony Agostinelli trailer. Supervisors to monitor his actions.

The resident on Red Fox Lane is trying to get Armstrong Cable to extend their service to his property. Will keep the Supervisors informed.

Action on the pay for lawn mowing was tabled until next meeting.

The office is to be closed for two weeks beginning May 21st.

A reminder that the Township Clean-up Day is May 11th from 8-12 with the fee to be \$10.00 for automobiles. Boots motioned and Radich second to leave it up to the discretion of the Supervisors at the sites to charge up to \$60.00 per load for large trucks, trailers and containers.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
