

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 10, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road patching and crack sealing and DoVidio's driveway discharge, and the road crew.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the minutes of the April 12, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. It was noted that an executive session was held after the April meeting for personnel issues.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report and discussion of the status of McCartney Hollow Road, getting a contractor to do the widening and discussion of what roads are to be done this year; Bates and Breakneck Bridge Road.

Permit reports were presented.

The various agenda items carried over were reviewed with discussion of their status.

Radich motioned and Zias second to ratify the appointment of Tim Boots as the signer for the paperwork for the 2018 F550 truck. Motion passed with all in favor. The truck chassis is to be done in two weeks then taken to Walsh Equipment for the hydraulics and plow to be installed.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the hiring of Bryan Czerpak as a full time road laborer, effective April 16, 2018. Motion passed with all in favor. Czerpak will be on probation per the job description.

SWIF asked about the Supervisors setting up a physician's panel – they decided not to.

Some issues are to be checked into with Code.sys since their main inspector left.

The Supervisors are not going to pursue getting any residents financial information for CDBG county funds at this time.

The Miller property complaint status was discussed with the Supervisors deciding to have the township Solicitor take care of it. The secretary is to get information to him to send to her for possible blight removal, etc.
