

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
May 13, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 13, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, no visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the April 8, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to charge half of the township \$50.00 (\$25.00) construction fee to township residents who are Veteran's. Proof of their Veteran status must be presented with the building permit application. Motion passed with all in favor.

Perry Township Annual Clean-up Day report was given. Low turnout and it was suggested that next year be scheduled different than hunting and fishing seasons.

Discussion was held about Martha Miller's trailer on Hickernell Road. A letter is to be sent to the property owner with the deadline of the end of August to get the trailer removed or the township will hire a company to do it and a lien will be put against the property.

The confusion with the building permit fees charged was discussed and the possibility of getting a second companies process was discussed with not action taken at this time.

Boots motioned and Radich second to rescind the motions for the purchase and lease agreement for the JCB 110W. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a 55Z-1 Midi Excavator from Stephenson Equipment for \$79,164.93. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a 2021 5711D Massey Ferguson Tractor and a Tiger 22' Bengal Boom Rotary Mower/50' Head from Stephenson Equipment for \$132,589.21. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to have Boots and Marshall be the signers for the Midi Excavator and the Massey Ferguson Tractor and Tiger Boom Mower from Stephenson and to take out the Lease with First National Bank. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 5-13-21 for the appointment of Janice Marshall and John Zias as the authorized electronic signers for the PennDot Engineering and Construction Management System "ECMS" and the Reimbursement Agreement System "RAS" upon approval of such contracts by the Perry Township Board of Supervisors, for all projects located in Perry Township. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to have the Chairman, John Zias sign the Lobbying Certification Form to verify that no federal funds shall be used for Lobbying in connection with the Barkley Road Bridge TIP/EMCS program. Motion passed with all in favor.

Solicitor Greg Fox sent the letter to the Mountville Salvage Owners, John and Herman Stafford requesting the removal of their junk from property across the road from the designated junk yard area.

The District 11-0 representatives contacted the Township about the water problem at the intersection of Mercer Road, Portersville Road and Palo Alto Drive. Documentation was sent to them that PennDot was to have taken care of the problem through an Agility Project for when Perry Township provided winter snow removal in 2017-2018 on Pleasant Hill Road.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
