

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
May 14, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radish and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and one visitor was present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: No visitors attended.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the April 2, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the low bids for the emulsion, aggregates and fuels. Motion passed. McClymonds Supply and Transit was the only bidder for aggregates; Russell Standard had the low bid for CRS-2 10,000 gallons FOB; Suit-Kote was the low bidder for the CRS-2 30,000 gallons delivered; Hei-Way was the low bidder for premium Cold patch; and Reed Oil was the low bidder for on road diesel fuel and heating oil. All products were bid more or less.

Announcements: The Perry Township Clean-Up Day is cancelled – possibly to reschedule.

The township office is temporarily closed to the public and will open when the county goes “green” for business.

The salt contract was changed for 2020-21 season to 60 tons. Need to get this year's supply ordered.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 5-14-20 for the 2020 property taxes for Perry Township tax collection period to be the same as the Ellwood City Area School District. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to appoint Janice Marshall as Tax Collector to replace Dorothy Wallace who resigned May 11, 2020. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pay for the RAK tax collection program and to do so for all future tax collectors. The cost this year is \$300 with the school paying half and the township paying half. Motion passed.

The appointment of a Deputy Tax Collector to replace Janice Marshall was tabled until June.

The election is June 2 and remains here at the municipal building.

Boots motioned and Radich second to approve the tax credit payments to the volunteers in the Wurtemberg Perry fire department who paid township property taxes in 2019. Motion passed.

Radich motioned and Boots second to ratify the rental expense for an excavator from Stephenson Equipment for approximately \$4,300 to be used for the McCartney Hollow Road slide repair. Motion passed.

Residents are reminded to complete their 2020 Census forms that will benefit all residents and the funding that the township and various organizations could be eligible for.

It was decided to junk the irreparable speed trailer.

The Perry Township Office is closed temporarily due to the COVID-19 Virus. The Secretary monitor, when possible, the messages and take care of the mail/bills, etc.

Boots motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
