

Perry Township Board of Supervisors June 9, 2011 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 9, 2011 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Dori McElwain was absent. Solicitor Greg Fox and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 3 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-discussed the Portersville Road closure, River Road needing crack sealing and that 280 Butler Avenue has been sold and cleaned up; Jeff Cable-driveway paving process, stormwater management applications, and Pine Lake Road work.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the May 12, 2011 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that the arbitration hearing with the Butler County Sewage Association was held on May 25, 2011 in the Lawrence County Courthouse and that Timothy Boots, John Zias, Janice Marshall and Greg Fox were present on behalf of Perry Township. Dori McElwain was present with the Butler County Sewage Association.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the financial report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster Report was presented with information from Boots and discussion on the West Lancaster Road Bridge; the Barkley Road Bridge #2 closure situation; the Pfeifer Road culvert wash out and repairs and the repairs for McCartney Hollow Road Bridge.

Permits and the stormwater management exemptions were presented.

Residents were reminded that the elected tax collector, Dorothy Wallace will be collecting taxes for Perry Township and the Ellwood City School at her residence and at her scheduled hours posted on the tax bills to be sent out.

There was a discussion about the proper permits and process for a gas well coming into the township and what has been done so far.

Greg Fox presented the results of the arbitration hearing, with the award amount that Perry Township is to pay set at \$3,000. Greg Fox was thanked for his representation in the case.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed.
