

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 10, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 10, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, one visitor present. Visitor Comments: River Road-Dovidio driveway runoff onto road and road crew did good job in patching streets off of River Road.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the May 13, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Radich motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. It was announced that the 2020 Financial Audit is complete with no findings.

Radich motioned and Zias second to approve the change in the tractor/boom mower to a toggle switch control that brings the total cost of the equipment to \$219,735.74. Motion passed with all in favor.

Complaints were received about the trees on Mile Hill Road by Bollinger's; brush needs cut on Van Gorder Mill Road; The Solicitor sent a letter to Martha Miller about trailer and property on Hickernell Road.

Boots motioned and Zias second to submit a letter and application to the Lawrence County Commissioners requesting \$30,000 in financial assistance from the County Liquid Fuels Funds to help with the purchase of the new equipment. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Radich second to pass resolution 6-10-21 Application for County Aid for \$30,000 to help with the cost of the 2021 Massey Ferguson Tractor, Tiger Boom mower and the JCB Midi Excavator. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to pass resolution 6-10-21-2 Authorization of small borrowing of \$219,735.74 for capital equipment purchases. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to pass resolution 6-21-21-3 providing for the supplemental appropriations for the 2021 Budget due to income and expense increase of \$96,662.02 from the American Rescue Funds. Motion passed with all in favor.

Status: Nothing heard yet: The District 11-0 representatives contacted the Township about the water problem at the intersection of Mercer Road, Portersville Road and Palo Alto Drive. Documentation was sent to them that PennDot was to have taken care of the problem through an Agility Project for when Perry Township provided winter snow removal in 2017-2018 on Pleasant Hill Road.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
