

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 11, 2015 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, 2015 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: George McCool – Hardy property on Reno Road needs cleaned up, cement work in front of building looks good.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the minutes of the May 14, 2015 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. Boots commented on the bid proposal received for the equipment rental for the seal coating project this summer (within a month) and Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to accept the lowest bid for equipment rental for seal coating to be done within a month. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias is asking for Oliastro to be contacted for a bid since Russell Standard and Youngblood are not interested.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second that the township used printed is to be given away due to incompatibility with the township computer. Motion passed with all in favor.

Concern about McCartney Hollow Bridge deck deteriorating – Boots showed photos of the work done previously and stated that he would have the road crew work on it next week. Lookout Avenue was also discussed and Boots stated that he would get the road crew working on it after the bridge repairs.

The request for information about a property appeals board through the COG was discussed and decided that the board is not interested.

The Act 13 Impact Fund fees for the year are to be \$31,379.02.

Boots stated that he was not interested in participating in the Dirt and Gravel Road Program this year.

The Secretary is to contact the distributor trailer company about the title for the trailer. The trailer was delivered on June 1.

Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to grant permission to the Wurtemberg-Perry VFD to close Hickernell Road to through traffic, on July 25 for a mutual aid structure burn training class. Motion passed with all in favor.

The photographs were emailed on June 2 to the inspection company after the bridge closed barriers were put back in place.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to authorize Boots to put a bid into the Lawrence County COG for the asphalt zipper if it is put out for sale by bids. The amount is to be the amount recommended and agreed on by the Board of Supervisors. Motion passed with all in favor.

An update was presented on the status of the Barkley Road Bridge #2 that was received from FB Taylor Engineering.

Zias motioned and Schlemmer second to adjourn. Motion passed.
