

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 11, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radish and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and three visitors were present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawloski-status of McCartney Hollow Road slide area; Nina Grossman and Michael Mazur-complaint and problem with neighbors dogs barking, running loose, aggressiveness; Boots to check into problem.

Radich motioned and Boors second to accept the minutes of the May 14, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots signed the audit paperwork for the Federal Funds received for the Barkley Bridge completed in 2019.

The Roadmaster and reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to ratify the contract signed for the interim audit of the tax collection account following the resignation of Dorothy Wallace as Tax Collector. Motion passed with all in favor. Marshall to get the township property from Wallace. Announcements: The Perry Township Clean-Up Day is cancelled – possibly to reschedule.

August 1st is the annual Perry Township Clean-up Day.

Marshall announced that she took the Tax Collector Test and has received her identification account information.

The problem with the recycling bid was discussed. Boots motioned and Radich second to approve the five year contract with Valley at the cost of \$261.08 per month with a onetime drop off fee. Motion passed with all in favor. Marshall is to check with the county to make sure they won't be getting any bins in the near future.

Boots motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
