

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 12, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 12, 2014 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Coty Brandon and nine visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-grader location; John Diebold-Levis Road condition and when it is to be completed, parking of equipment there, wants project completed; Sgt. Dristol-New Castle State Police-introduced himself, commented on minimum of problems in township, need to have speed limit signs every half mile to be enforced; George McCool-Reno Road work is appreciated, need for markers at end of culvert put along his property; Delores Zadalac-burning problem – Zias to check into; Miles Heitzenrater-water line status for Grandview Road, need to check with County Commissioners, Rex and Shell gas companies, PA Rural Water for financial assistance.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the May 8, 2014 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Schlemmer motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. It was noted that the 2012-13 Liquid Fuels Audit was completed with no findings.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

Zias motioned and Boots second to approve the purchase of stone and emulsion for the seal coating of VanGorder Mill Road, the Perry School area streets in Wurtemberg area, Reno Road and West Lancaster Road from the township line to Shingle Hollow Road. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to approve the rental of a crack sealing machine at the best price. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 6-12-14 Sign Maintenance Policy for Perry Township. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to approve the "Granny Platt" temporary dwelling unit agreement and application forms for immediate family hardship cases. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to approve the name of "Marcies Lane" for the Hunt/Hulburt lane. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced by the PUC that Perry Township's 2013 allotment for the Act 13 funds will be \$37,628.56. The Lawrence County Commissioners approved the grant for the Barkley Road Bridge #2 in the amount of \$53,500.

A letter was sent to Martha Miller about her property needing maintained on Hickernell Road. The Chester Kriebel property and Suzie Greene property was discussed.

The cost of the clean-up day was \$2,315.38 plus cost of equipment.

Zias motioned and Boots second to approve the use of Dambach Lane for the subdivision on John Dambach and Donna Dambach. Motion passed with all in favor.

There may be a company to solicitate Perry Township residents. They are required to get a permit and residents and businesses can post a no solicitation sign in their property if they wish.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to approve Diane Sheets to use the driveway of Jay Tuttle for her "temporary hardship" trailer without requiring there to be a lane name. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to approve and sign the "Granny Platt" agreement with Jay and Mindy Tuttle for the hardship case of Diane Sheets. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to allow Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall to be added to the township health insurance with the cost of the premiums to be paid by her. Motion passed.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed. An executive session was held following the meeting concerning personnel issues.
