

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 13, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 13, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer and Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and 2 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Denise Zadalak-thank you for curb repair.

Schlemmer motioned and Zias second to accept the minutes of the May 9, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and permit reports were presented. The fire department is to be contacted to have an inspection of the four junkyards in the township for accessibility, etc.

Boots is to contact the District Office about the inspections of the Barkley Road Bridge #2 while closed.

A complaint was received about an abandoned property at 306 Robin Street - Boots is working with the bank to get it maintained. There was discussion about the property on the triangle lot at Cutoff Street and Portersville Road. It is to be monitored for visibility limitations.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to ratify the purchase of the dust control materials including stone for the tar and chipping later this year which included 598.61 tons of #8 limestone @ \$11,038.37 and 10,150 gallons of E1 Emulsion @ \$16,037.00. Sections of Bates, Hickernell, Lovers College, Mile Hill, Stickle, Bauder Mill, and West Lancaster Roads were done. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots is to get a damage amount for a bill to be sent to JB Mill for logging damage on Stickle Road.

It was reported that a claim was turned into the worker's compensation carrier for a volunteer fire fighter who was injured at the fire call on June 7.

Zias motioned and Boots second to pass Resolution 6-13-13 Prevailing Wage Adjustment Request. Motion passed with all in favor.

The locations of stop signs and the parking problems in the Wurtemberg Heights area were discussed. Any complaints about parking are to be followed up with the Supervisors responding to mark the township right on way with paint.

Possible seal coating to be done this summer is 1/2 mile of Bauder Mill Road, 1/4 mile of West Lancaster Road and 1/4 mile of Stickle Road.

It was announced that the referendum on opening the township up for liquor sales passed at the election by 208 to 107. It was suggested to contact David Marks about the projected project of the former grange hall.

A report was presented on the successful Spring Clean-up May 18.

Boots reported that he has been checking on the house on Meadowland Avenue where an addition is being done.

The Fire Escrow Ordinance was tabled until the solicitor can be present.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to revise the previous months motion to approve the purchase three doors and frames and kick plates for the township building for up to \$600.00 each and to be either steel or fiberglass. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Supervisors decided against the request from the Lawrence County Conservation Department for the Supervisors to send a letter about the financing cuts to their.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Ordinance #3-13-13 for enforcement proceedings of all township ordinances. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Community Yard Sale is set for July 20 from 8-2:00 p.m. at the municipal building with the 27 as a rain date.

Boots is to check with Ruth Yvorra about permission to place a marquee on her property by the township sign before a sign is purchased.

Zias motioned to adjourn and Boots second with all in favor.
