

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
June 14, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 14, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. John Zias was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road patching, gas line and DoVidio's driveway discharge, and the second bridge.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the May 10, 2018 and June 2, 2018 meetings. Motion passed with all in favor. It was noted that an executive session was held after the June 2, 2018 special meeting for personnel issues.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report and permit reports were presented.

The various agenda items carried over were reviewed with discussion of their status. Boots stated he would have the township remove the junk truck on Bates Road belonging to the Sturgeon family to their property prior to the tar and chip project.

Trumco has acquired a road bond for Pfeifer and Magee Roads.

The Miller property complaint status was discussed. Boots is to check on the status of the removal and take photos if possible.

Complaints received about Tony Agostinelli burning tires – copy of two township ordinances were sent to him and to DEP. DEP responded that they are satisfied with our regulations.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase a portable radio for the township EMA at a cost of up to \$4,500. To discuss with the township fire chief for the best recommendation for overall coverage and long term use. Motion passed.

Boots is to contact PennDot New Castle to set up some Agility work for the winter maintenance done this year.

Bates Road measurement was completed by the District Office and the township road crew is to mark it with a sign.

Discussion about 112 Whieldon Avenue property and house condition. A certified letter is to be sent to the owner, Augustine. Greg Fox is to check on a property maintenance ordinance to help with situations like it.

Following complaints about the Hardy property on Reno Road, a certified letter is to be sent again to the owners.

Boots motioned and Radich second to have Paul Boots Roofing put a new metal roof on the Fire Department portion of the township building for less than six thousand. If over six thousand, three bids are to be gotten. Motion passed.

The possibility of enacting a fireworks ordinance was discussed with the Supervisors deciding against it.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase Construction Vehicle – Keep Back, signs for the tailgates of the township trucks and the new triangle signs for the equipment where needed. Motion passed

Marshall is to get five safety yellow shirts for each of the road crew to wear daily at work.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
