

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
July 9, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 9, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radish and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and Solicitor Greg Fox were in attendance. No visitors were present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the June 11, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Audit report has been received from Herrmann and Loll with no findings. The PUC gas well distribution has been received for the production in 2019.

The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented. Boots gave an update on the McCartney Hollow Slide work. Following review of the Junk Yard Ordinance, it is possible for the Junk Yard Permit to be transferred to a new owner who must follow the same regulations as the previous owner.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Ordinance 7-9-20 Setting the Fee Schedule and Compensation for the Perry Township Tax Collector. Motion passed with all in favor. No record of an ordinance was found in the past records and it is required per the Tax Collection Law.

Penn Power notified the township that they will be trimming trees in the township.

August 1st is the annual Perry Township Clean-up Day with the same regulations and fees as last year.

The complaint about the dogs running loose in Wilson Avenue area, scaring, barking, etc. was discussed. A video of the dogs was viewed and the dog warden was contacted. Boots is to contact the warden and show them the video and try to get help with the problem.

Complaints have been received about the junk across the road from Mountville Salvage. The Solicitor is to send a letter to the property owner and the owner of the junk to get it cleaned up and removed.

The Solicitor is to send Badger/Kopnitsky, the property owners on Bauder Mill Road, a letter concerning all the junk and trash needing to be cleaned up.

Boots motioned and Radich second to have Marshall and Boots be the designated signers on any documents for the TIP program for Barkley Road Bridge #3. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
