

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
July 11, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor's comments: Paul Walsh-representing the Carpenters Union, comments on Route 488 trees and any projects in the township; Barry Kline – flooding from behind homes, to continue attending if township doesn't help find a way to solve problem, (told by Supervisors and Solicitor that the problem is on his property and not the townships-the township will not tell him what to do nor give him permission)

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the June 13, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Inoperable vehicles located on Cernus property at 308 Rose Street, with no license, etc.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the letter requesting to have the Barkley Road Bridge grant from the Lawrence County Commissioners increased in the amount to cover the remaining cost of the bridge work. Motion passed with all in favor. It was announced that the Commissioners approved the request.

The 2018 PUC Ace 13 distribution for Perry Township has been received in the amount of \$20,718.26.

The condition of Grandview Road was discussed with Radich questioning the berm being eroded away below Boots driveway and is concerned about losing the road.

Following discussion, Boots motioned and Zias second to temporarily close Nye Road to traffic between 1005 and 275. Motion passed with all in favor.

PennDot representative contacted the township about the water problem at 488, Mercer Road and Palo Also Drive. It was decided to use the \$2,500 funds left from the winter snow removal that the township did for PennDot in 2017 to help cover the cost to fix the problem

The 2020 Peterbilt truck is ready to be delivered once the paperwork is signed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to have Boots be the authorized signer for the 2020 Peterbilt truck from Hunter's Truck Sales. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that North Tower Road Bridge will be closed through July 19 for repairs.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
