

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
July 12, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 12, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-River Road gas line and DoVidio's driveway discharge; Ms Zadalak-township ordinances.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the June 14, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report and permit reports were presented.

Boots stated he would have the township remove the junk truck on Bates Road belonging to the Sturgeon family to their property the next week.

The Miller property complaint status was discussed with the decision for the solicitor to send a deadline letter to the property owner.

Boots motioned and Radich second to send a letter to the other four owners of the asphalt zipper notifying them that Perry Township will not be renewing the insurance on it in December and wish to remove their name as part owner due to the conflict Mahoning Township has created. Motion passed. The action is to be taken prior to the next meeting.

Zias motioned and Radich second to accept the bid of \$15,370 Equipment Rental from Russell Standard for the tar and chipping of the township roads to include Breakneck and Bates Roads. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots stated that he will be ordering 800 tons of #8 and #2 aggregate for the project.

Mekis Construction has been selected low bidder for the Barkley Road Bridge replacement by Stickle Road. All documents to date have been completed.

Following discussion and receiving recommendation from F.B. Taylor Engineering, Boots motioned and Radich second to begin replacement of a small bridge by 2221 Barkley Road due to failing beams. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to have Paul Boots Roofing add the installation of Alcoa Leaf Relief Gutter Screen to the roofing project on the VFD garage portion of the municipal building. Motion passed with all in favor.

The request for a donation to "Visit Lawrence County"; the placement of a mirror at Route 488 and Pfeifer Roads; for a septic waiver for the Killeen property were all discussed and denied.

Following information received from the Lawrence County Recycling about improper items placed in the recycling bins, Boots motioned and Zias second to have a sign made for out by the recycling bins to encourage proper disposal of materials and not to cost more than \$200 for a 3' x 3' sign. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
