

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
August 8, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 8, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. John Zias was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- River Road seal coating, dip in River Road by bridge, Pfeifer Road not in bad condition since seal coated.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the July 11, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. The distributor truck for emulsion has been ordered for the end of August for seal coating all of Mile Hill Road and on Grandview Road from Boot's driveway to Tom Shinsky's driveway.

Boots motioned and Radich second to close out the Fire Apparatus Checking Account, ending in 9899 and transfer the funds into a new checking account with the same information due to a conflict with the account number. Two signatures will be required with the three Supervisors and Secretary/Treasurer qualified to be the authorized signers. Motion passed with all in favor.

A complaint has been received concerning inoperable vehicles located on the John Cernus property at 308 Rose Street, Ellwood City with the Supervisors agreeing to send a certified letter giving a notice to remove the vehicles by the end of October.

It was announced that the county sent out Interim Tax Bills for construction completed and that it is important to pay these bills. They are in addition to the regular bills sent out. If left unpaid, the accounts will be sent to the tax claim bureau and considered delinquent.

The condition of the International Dump Truck was discussed and it was decided to keep it as long as possible.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase the Extended Warranty through Hunters on the new Peterbilt truck to include all three sections of the warranty. Motion passed with all in favor.

Nye Road was closed on August 7<sup>th</sup> to traffic between 1005 and 275 due to berm eroding away from all the storms and concerns for the safety of those traveling it.

Boots stated the tree had been removed on the Daufen property on McCartney Hollow Road and Penn Power has been notified to proceed with moving the power line/pole so that the road widening can be completed.

A second slide is happening on McCartney Hollow Road by the Bellian property and the township is working on resolving it before the road is involved.

The condition of the Miller property on Hickernell Road was discussed with information received that the property owner has passed away and the property is possibly being sold so the matter is being tabled.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
