

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
August 12, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 12, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, one visitor present. Visitor Comments: Sam Pawlowski, River Road-Dovidio driveway runoff, new excavator, water line work

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the July 8, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was noted that beginning the end of August, the township will be required to post their meeting agenda prior to the meeting on the township website and at the meeting location.

A request was received for the Supervisors to consider making a donation to Hunter Rock's Eagle Scout Project of building a pavilion for the Wurtemberg Methodist Church. Following discussion Tim Boots made a motion and John Zias second to donate \$5,000.00 from the American Rescue Plan Fund that allows expenditures to 501.3c churches. Confirmation was received of the eligibility after contacting PSATS. Motion passed.

The JCB Excavator has been received. The Massey Ferguson tractor and boom mower will be delivered the end of September.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 8-12-21 to submit an application to the Lawrence County Commissioners for Act 13 County Transportation Aid funds in the amount of \$85,500.00 for the replacement of the TIP Barkley Road Bridge #3. The amount represents the township 5 % share of the replacement cost. Motion passed.

The Perry Township Tax Collector is reminding residents that the Ellwood City Area School District has changed the company that will be collecting the delinquent taxes for the school taxes. It is important that residents get their taxes paid as the failure to do so will result in large penalty amounts and even the possibility of the company being able to sell the property.

Following discussion, Boots motioned and Zias second to get telephone bids and purchase at the best rate, a trailer to haul the township equipment with the amount no to exceed \$15,000. Motion passed with all in favor.

Status: Nothing heard yet: The District 11-0 representatives contacted the Township about the water problem at the intersection of Mercer Road, Portersville Road and Palo Alto Drive. Documentation was sent to them that PennDot was to have taken care of the problem through an Agility Project for when Perry Township provided winter snow removal in 2017-2018 on Pleasant Hill Road.

Boots motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
