

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
August 13, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 13, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radish via phone conference and Tim Boots. John Zias was absent for medical issues. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall was in attendance. No visitors were present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the July 9, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The firm of Herrmann and Loll have completed the audit for the Tax Collector Dorothy Wallace following her resignation in May. The report will be received at a later date.

The Roadmaster and permit reports were presented. Boots gave an update on the McCartney Hollow Slide work.

The county has funds available for the township to reimburse for the COVID-19 expense. The Supervisors decided there weren't enough expenses to submit to the county for reimbursement.

Penn Power notified the township that they will be trimming trees in the township.

August 1st was the annual Perry Township Clean-up Day with a good turnout from the residents.

The complaint about the dogs running loose in Wilson Avenue area, scaring, barking, etc. was discussed. A video of the dogs was viewed and the dog warden was contacted. Boots tried several times to contact the warden and show them the video and try to get help with the problem. To contact them again.

Complaints have been received about the junk across the road from Mountville Salvage. The Solicitor is to send a letter to the property owner and the owner of the junk to get it cleaned up and removed. Photos are to be taken prior to Fox sending the letter.

The Solicitor is to send Badger/Kopnitsky and Watt, the property owners on Bauder Mill Road, a letter concerning all the junk and trash needing to be cleaned up. Photos are to be taken prior to Fox sending the letter.

Radich motioned and Boots second to remove Jodi Rock from the Agricultural Security Board and replace her with Michael Sinclair, son of Michael and Teresa Sinclair. Motion passed with all in favor.
