

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 8, 2016 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. John Zias was absent. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were in attendance.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-location of grader; Roy Magee-catch basin and culvert on Magee Road
Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the August 11, 2016 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster report and permit reports were presented.

Received a request for a street light at Hansen and River Road intersection. The secretary is to submit a request to First Energy.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase new work shirts and lined sweatshirts for the road crew at the total cost of \$348.99 from Construction Gear. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to ratify the signing of the July 27, 2016 letter of approval and the request for the supplement for the Barkley Road Bridge that is closed and in the TIP program. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to purchase an eight foot Gledhill roll spreader from Walsh Equipment for \$3,210 uninstalled. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Supervisors decided they were not interested in participating in the Dirt and Gravel Road Program.

The problem with the CRS-2 material received from Russell Standard was resolved with no charge for the product.

A notice has been posted on the board about the status of the Moraine Dam.

Another resident has been approved for the low income housing repair grant. The construction of "Tiny Houses" as seen on TV was discussed and how to handle their building permits when necessary.

Notice has been received from the Lawrence County Treasurer that there will be a new program for the 2017 Tax Outreach Program. Veterans who has their Form DD214 registered in the Lawrence County Court House, will be eligible for a free Photo ID.

An open house will be held on September 16 at Murphy Tractor in Harmony on September 16.

Property on Mercer Road has cleaned up some of the garbage piled up on it and the shrubbery blocking the Mercer Road traffic was discussed with the road crew to check on and trim if still needed.

It was announced and flyers available that there will be a special recycling event at the Lawrence County Fairgrounds on September 24 from 10-1:00 p.m. for hard to dispose items – a fee will be charged.

1. The shop fan and lawn mower have been purchased;
2. The status of the COG and zipper is still unknown – was suggested to get together with the owners of the zipper to try to get a solution before the insurance is due;
3. The pull behind street sweeper ordered from Walsh Equipment is there and is being finished for delivery.
4. The request for county aid funds for the sweepers was denied at this time – can possibly reapply in December;
5. Davevic has notified the township of the renewal options. The Supervisors agreed to keep everything the same.
6. The school lights have had the times corrected and the parts are ordered for the repair.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
