

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 9, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall was absent. One visitor was present. No Visitor Comments.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the August 12, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that the damaged trailer owned by Martha Miller on Hickernell Road is to be removed by her niece.

Other permit reports and the roadmaster report were distributed. Also distributed were the Lawrence County Recycling notices for special collections.

A notice from DEP that they will be working on an abandoned mine on the Twentier Farm. Stephenson expects late September for the delivery of the Massey Ferguson and boom mower.

The Lawrence County Commissioners have approved the Perry Township grant application for Act 13 County Transportation Aid Funds for the replacement of the TIP Program Barkley Road Bridge # 3. The amount approved is \$85,500.

The 2020 Census report shows that Perry Township went from 1938 to 1853 population.

Status: Nothing heard yet: The District 11-0 representatives contacted the Township about the water problem at the intersection of Mercer Road, Portersville Road and Palo Alto Drive. Documentation was sent to them that PennDot was to have taken care of the problem through an Agility Project for when Perry Township provided winter snow removal in 2017-2018 on Pleasant Hill Road.

Radich motioned and Zias second to adjourn. Motion passed.
