

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 13, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 13, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich, and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- second bridge to open Friday; Michelle Pekich-her applications for stormwater management and construction of a storage unit building.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the August 9, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report and permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to renew the township's liability and worker's compensation with EMC through Kilmer Insurance Group. Motion passed all in favor.

The procedure for the Stormwater Ordinance was discussed and agreed to leave the requirement the same that the township engineer must approve any stormwater plans over 2500 square feet or per the ordinance.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the PennDot presented by Pekich stating that no change in driveway status is needed for the stormwater plan. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to approve the Pekich stormwater Report as recommended by F.B. Taylor Engineering. Motion passed with all in favor.

A letter was received from the Postal Service about any new developments will be required to have a Cluster Box Unit from now on.

Following continued communication with Linda Angus for the Martha Miller property complaints on Hickernell Road, the township Solicitor Greg Fox presented the court documents on the matter. Boots signed the paperwork for filing at the courthouse.

Boots commented that he is still waiting for Penn Power to move the pole on McCartney Hollow Road so the widening of the road can be done.

Zias motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
