

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 14, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2017 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Roy Magee – culvert on Barkley Road, voting registration needs updated yearly.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the August 10, 2017 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 9-14-17 for the Adoption of the National Incident Management System. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was announced that on August 24 the township received a request from the Lawrence County Planning Department concerning the Census Boundary Updates for Perry Township. The Planning Department responds to the Census Boundary requests and suggested that the township lets them respond for the township since there is no need for duplicate information being sent in. The township submitted the desire to the Planning Department to represent the township.

Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise the Tax Incentive Ordinance for volunteer fire department members who own and reside in Perry Township. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to advertise the ordinance authorizing the WPVFD to bill the insurance companies for reimbursement for expenses from emergency responses. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Supervisors were reminded to be thinking of dates and information for the Budget Workshops to be held in October.

The Liquid Fuels allocation for 2018 is to be approximately \$121,164.89 and the Turnback allocation is \$15,360.

Zias motioned and Boots second to appoint Janice Marshall to be the third voting delegate/representative for Perry Township at the Lawrence County Regional Council of Governments meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to try using a different mechanic for future repairs to the township F-550 truck. Motion passed with all in favor.

The McCartney Hollow slide/widening project was discussed. The right-of-way has been completed by the township engineer. The Penn Power electric pole needs to be moved and is to be contacted. There are five pine trees that may also need to be removed – failure to do so may result in damage to their root system. Boots is to meet with the property owner and engineer to discuss further.

The Supervisors reviewed the status of various items/complaints carried over from previous meetings.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
