

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
October 8, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 8, 2020 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: James Radich and Tim Boots by telephone conference. John Zias was absent for medical issues. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and Solicitor Greg Fox were in attendance. One visitor was present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order.

Visitors Comments: Samuel Pawlowski – The Dovidio driveway on River Road and the work being done on Nye Road

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the September 10, 2020 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. The Tax Collection Audit has been completed and the report presented to the Supervisors. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the Audit Report. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster report and permits and tax collection report were handed out. Boots discussed Nye Road work that is being done.

Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise for the appointment of an outside audit firm for the 2020 financial records and to authorize the signing of the contract with Herrmann & Loll for the fee of \$2750 to complete the audit. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to set the 2021 budget workshop for October 18 at 4:00 p.m. and to advertise it. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to approve the UPMC health insurance renewal for 2021 and to keep the full time employees on the insurance. Motion passed.

Marshall gave a brief report on the county convention held in Hickory Township.

Trick or treat night is set for October 31<sup>st</sup> from 5-7:00 p.m.- same as Ellwood City and Ellport Borough.

Boots motioned and Radich second to renewal all insurance coverage with the current insurance companies. Motion passed.

The election will be held on November 3<sup>rd</sup> with the township voting location and the fire department open for voting.

It was decided to have the Solicitor send letters out to the Mountville Road property owner and Stafford who is storing junk on the property to get it cleaned up.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection Report and other permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
